

## THE ROLE

Our Hume, Canberra office is seeking a self-motivated Bin Inspector (casual position) to undertake the delivery of visual bin inspections in pre-determined areas in Canberra. This position will assist in achieving improved waste and sustainability outcomes for our customer and the community throughout the ACT.

This is a casual role, ideally suited to a current 3<sup>rd</sup> year university student (or motivated 2<sup>nd</sup> year) who has an environmental/sustainability passion and a love for early mornings and walking. The position will be initially for a 6 week period working up to 4 days per week. Shifts will be 4 hours (including travel time). The position will be a level 2 position in the waste management award with above award remuneration paid (casual).

## RESPONSIBILITIES

The key areas of responsibility are summarised below.

### Safety Environment and Quality

- Follow all safe work practices.
- Wear protective clothing, appropriate footwear and equipment as directed by the Project Coordinator

### Primary Duties

- Delivery of bin inspection programs – this means visually inspecting Garden Waste bins at the kerbside and recording data in pre-determined areas for 3 hours from first light on any given scheduled inspection day
- Data is to be recorded in the field using a handheld mobile device (provided)
- Inspections are conducted on weekdays only

## THE CANDIDATE

The successful candidate to join the EnviroCom team will require the following skills:

- Reliable, honest and responsible.
- Be flexible and able to adapt easily to completing new tasks if instructed to do so.
- Physically fit to complete up to 3 hours of walking in a single session

In addition, the candidate will be required to have:

- Access to email and an electronic calendar for exchange of information / inspection scheduling
- A mobile telephone for communication purposes
- A reliable motor vehicle to ensure that the individual is able to travel to and from the inspection areas
